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Summer Session 2010: International

Summer at Eldorado Emerson is an interesting, creative experience, designed to allow the child a broadening of educational opportunities for emotional and social well being, and the development of interpersonal and communication skills. Interesting activities, small classes, superb staff and wonderful students create the right atmosphere for learning and fun to occur. Students will participate in a wide range of age appropriate activities and are grouped, more or less, by age.

Eldorado Emerson's summer program is for students of high intelligence who want to be around interesting people and have the opportunity to explore areas in learning that are not always available.

The following courses are among those typically offered each summer – exact courses to be determined:

English Related Activities: Drama (Performance), Poetry, Creative Writing, ESL (English as a Second Language)

Art Related Activities: Drawing, Painting, Multi-media. **Art History:** Painting in the style of famous painters.

Ceramics: Shaping, firing, glazing and using the potter's wheel. Create interesting Object 'd Art.

Social Studies: SAT Preparation, Study Skills, History, Geography, Tutoring (additional charge)

Computer Related Activities: Typing, Computer Science, Programming, various Languages, including Visual Basic, Educational Computer Games

Science and Math: Astronomy and Earth Science, Human Anatomy, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, all math levels

Sports: Basketball, Tennis, Field Sports

Summer Session runs from **Monday, June 28th to Tuesday, July 27th**. School hours are from **9:00am until 3:00pm**.

Supervised care is available from 7:30am to 9:00am, and from 3:00pm until 6:00pm for \$5 per hour.

Summer tuition is \$1,200.00 (\$1,100.00 for siblings). A deposit of \$250.00 is due with each application.

The tuition balance is due before or on the first day of school.

I-20 is not required, unless the student would like their Summer Session units to apply towards their school transcript. If a New or Change of Status I-20 is requested, student must complete 'SEVIS Form', and submit additional \$250 to pay for the required I-901 & delivery. If student has a current I-20 to be transferred to Eldorado Emerson, add'l fee is not necessary.
