Summer Session 2011: Preschool through Elementary

Summer at Eldorado Emerson is an interesting, creative experience, designed to allow the child a broadening of educational opportunities for emotional and social well being, and the development of interpersonal and communication skills. Interesting activities, small classes, superb staff and wonderful students create the right atmosphere for learning and fun to occur. Students will participate in a wide range of age appropriate activities and are grouped, more or less, by age.

Ages 3 through Second Grade:

Reading - The reading program is continuous with the program in the regular school year. The children love reading and are very anxious to progress. They may perform a play or write a book. With the summer work in reading there will be less forgetting and more continuity for the child. New students at all levels will be considered individually.

Art - All students are involved in expression through art, using age appropriate materials. Expect beautiful, naïve, individualistic expressions from your son or daughter.

Monet Garden - Students will continue to create our Monet Garden. Pond life & biology will be taught to older children.

Ceramics (elementary) - Children create interesting, beautiful and sometimes useful objects with clay. Glazing processes will also be learned.

Third Grade through Sixth Grade:

Students will be involved in regular classes that may include: **English, Drama (performance), Poetry, Creative Writing, Cursive Writing, Cooking, Sewing, Social Studies, various Science classes, Math, Computer Science, Typing and Educational Computer Games (IBM Pentium, etc).** **Art:** Painting, Drawing, Multi-Media. Projects in Art History, creating in the styles of famous painters. **Ceramics:** Students create interesting, beautiful and useful objects with clay. They learn about shaping, firing and glazing, and may learn to use the potter's wheel. **Sports:** Basketball, Tennis, and Field Sports.

Tutoring: Available at an additional charge. *Exact courses to be determined.*

Summer Session runs from **Monday Monday, June 27th to Tuesday, July 26th**. School hours are from **9:00am until 3:00pm**. Supervision is available from 7:30am to 9:00am, and from 3:00pm until 6:00pm for \$5 per hour.

Summer tuition (applies to students not already enrolled in Eldorado Emerson) is \$1,000 (\$900.00 for siblings).

A deposit of \$250.00 is due with each application. The tuition balance is due on or before June 27th.

Preschoolers: See *Tuition Rate Sheet* for tuition based on schedule.

If a student new to Eldorado Emerson enrolls in Summer Session, and then enrolls for the upcoming school year (beginning September 2011), \$500 will be credited towards that student's fall enrollment.
